Classes at all Austin public schools will be canceled Monday while elementary schools hold parent-teacher conferences. Classes will resume Tuesday.

Two Supervisors Announced

Austin trustees on Monday named Paul Cruz and Ariel Cloud to supervise the district's middle schools and South Austin elementary schools, respectively.

Cruz will supervise 17 campuses as associate superintendent of middle schools. He has worked as the district's assistant superintendent for education support services since 2006.

Cloud will supervise 39 campuses as associate superintendent of South Austin elementary schools. She joined the district in 1986 and has served as a teacher, principal and director of early childhood education.

High School Gets Credit Union

A+ Federal Credit Union has opened a branch at San Marcos High School, the company announced Monday.

The A+ Federal Credit Union is the first in the Austin area to open a high school branch. The new location, at 2601 E. McCarty Lane, will be staffed by part-time, paid student tellers working at the branch as a part of the credit union's internship program, for which they will receive school credit.
