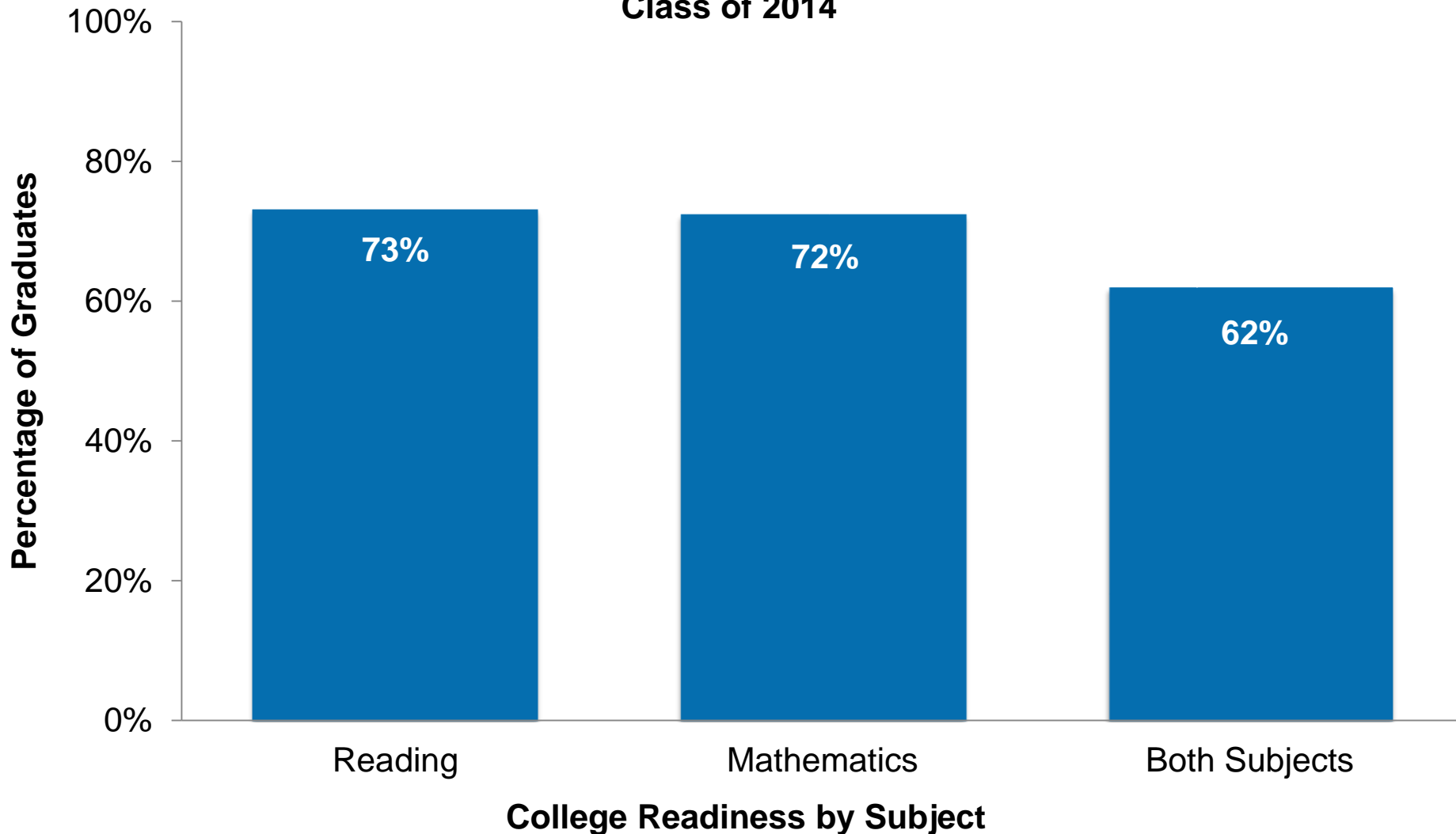

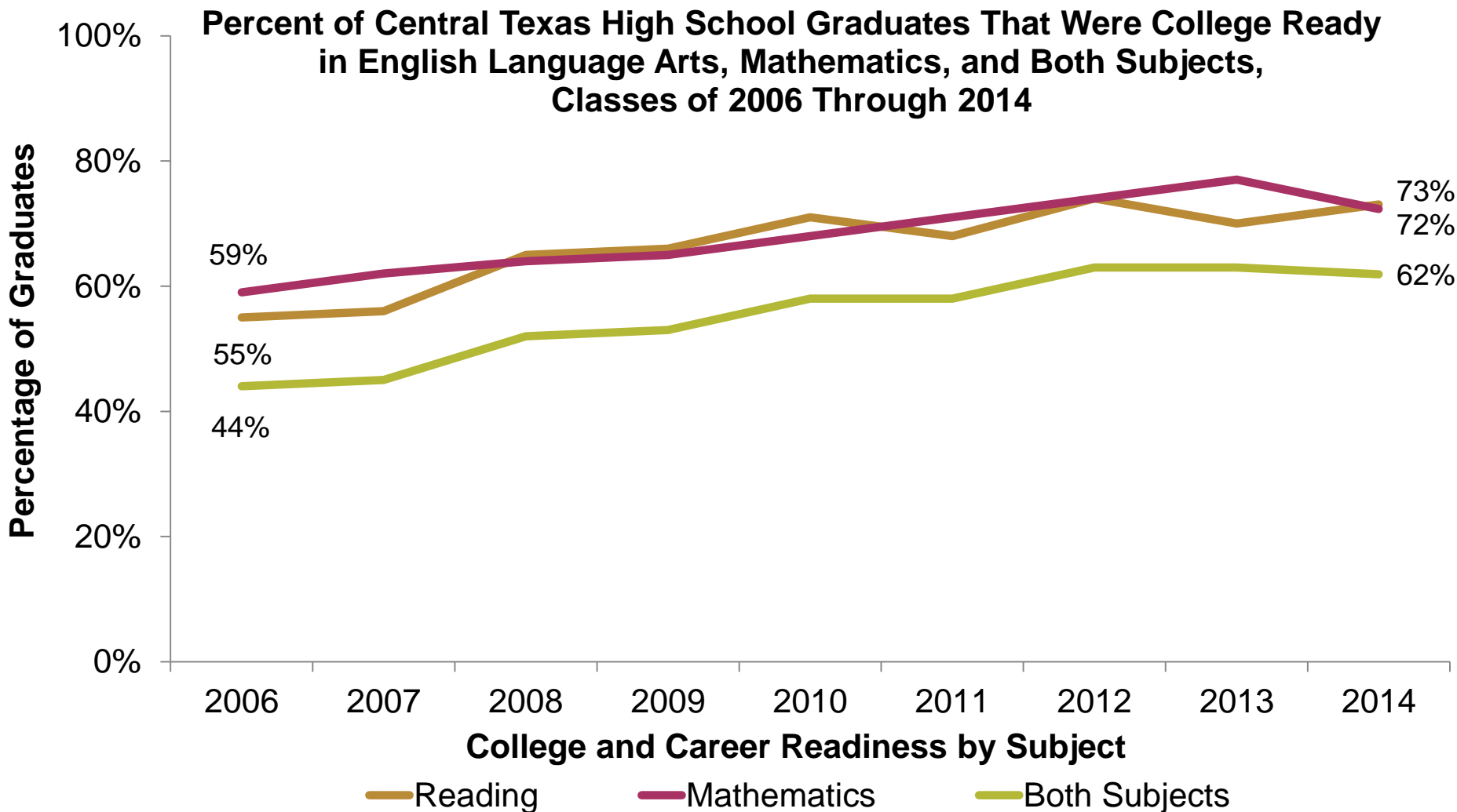

Class of 2014

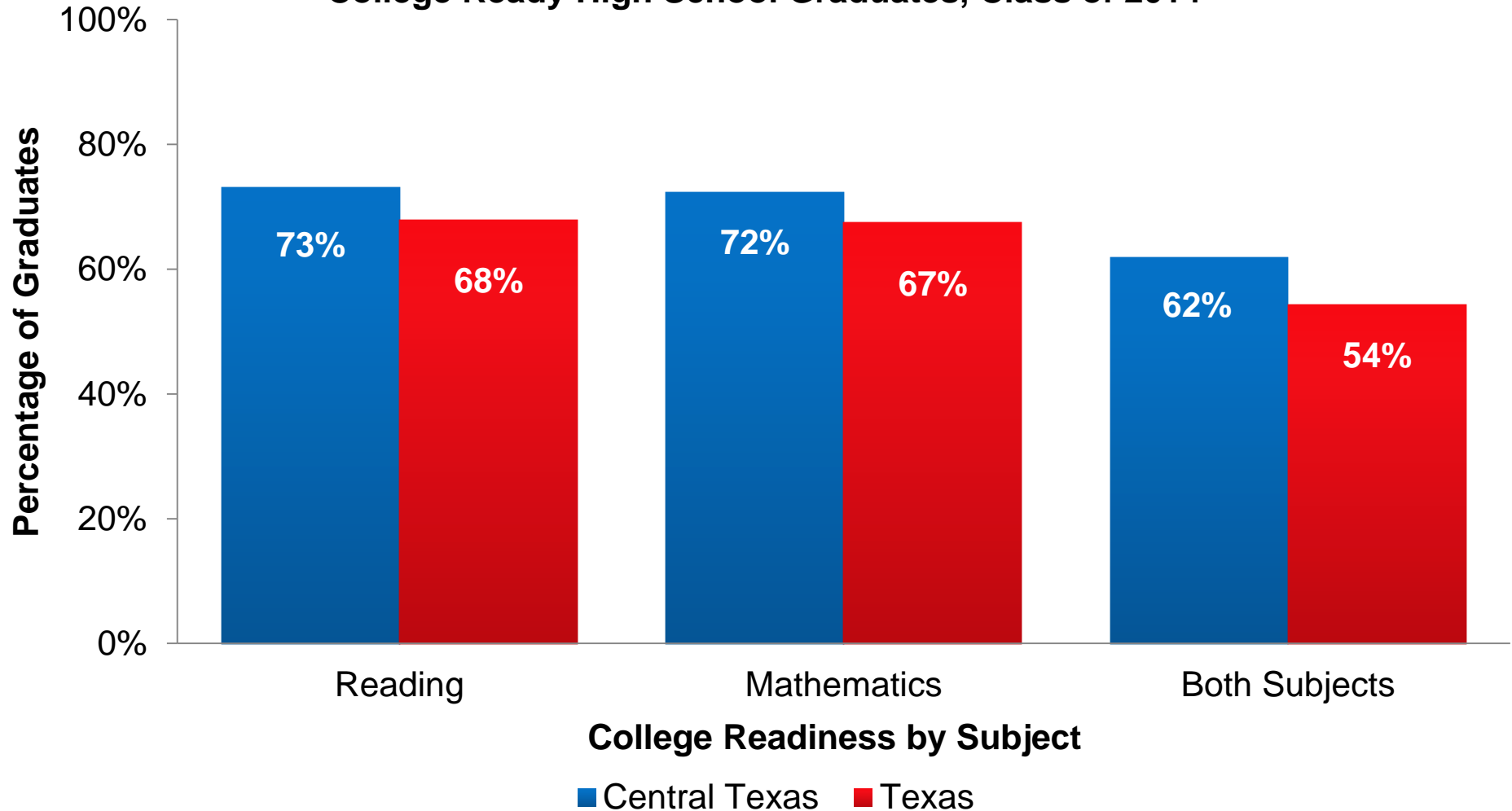


College Readiness Generally Increased Between 2006 and 2014



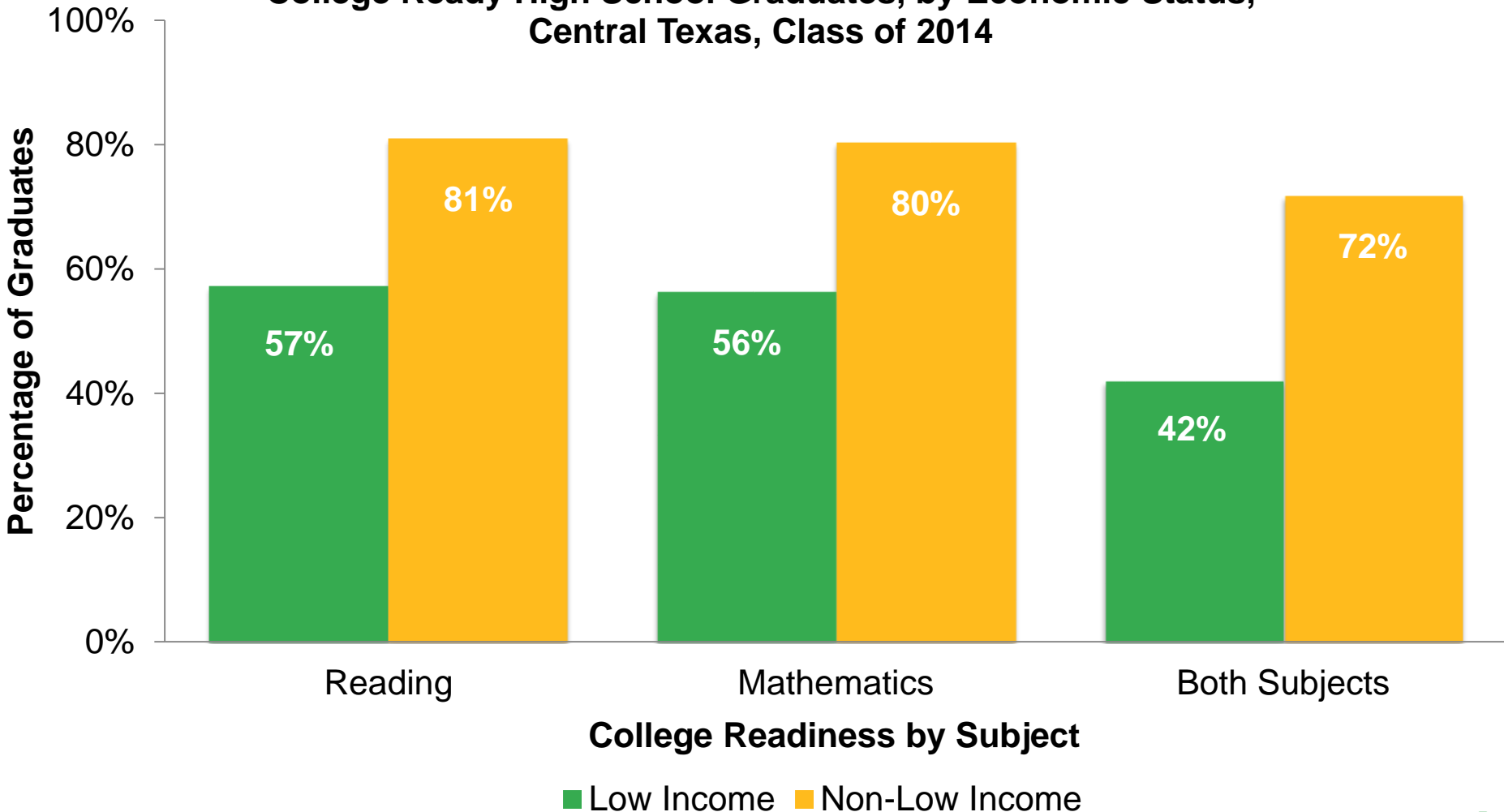
More Central Texas Graduates were College Ready than Texas Graduates

College Ready High School Graduates, by Economic Status, Central Texas, Class of 2014

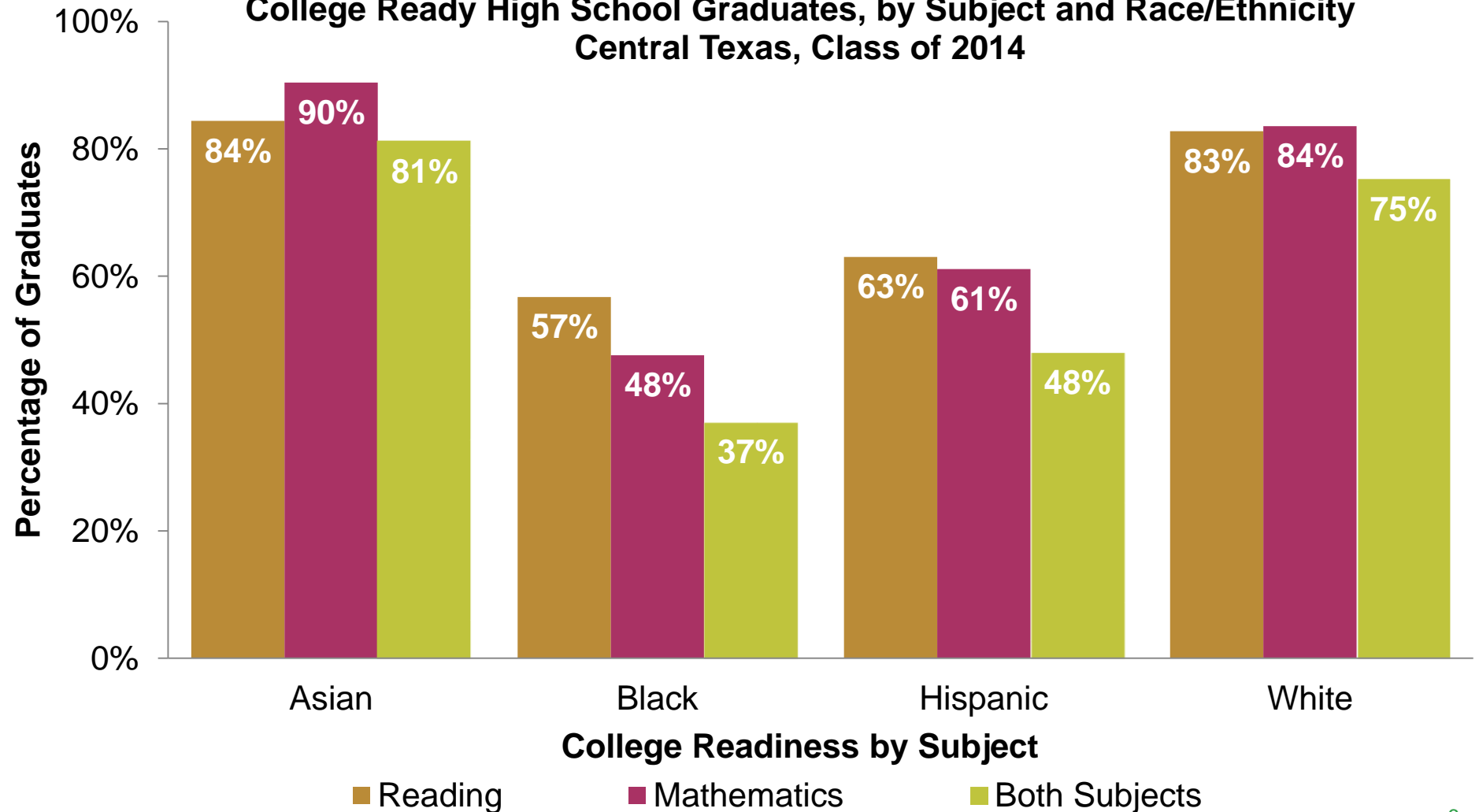

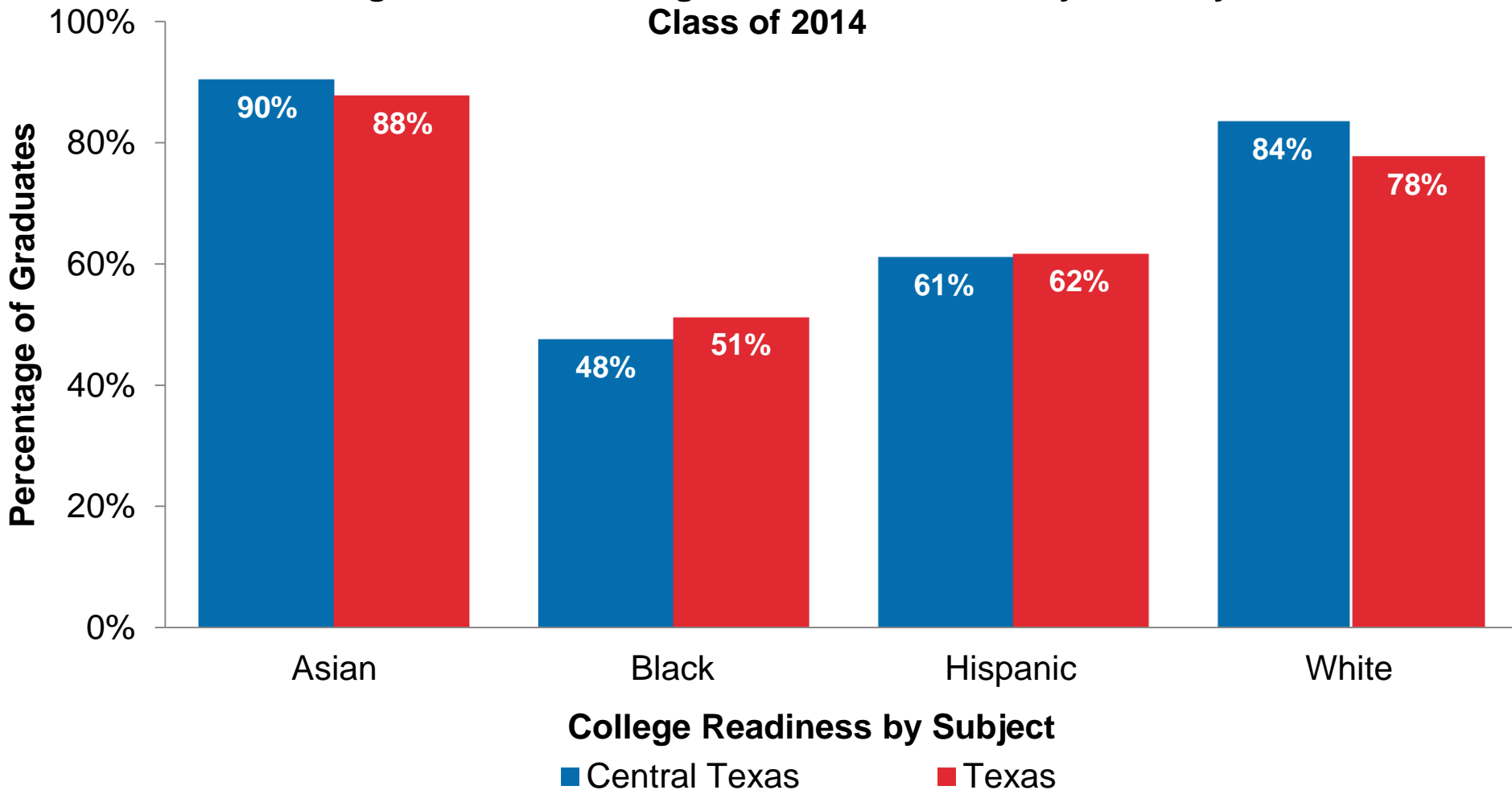
Large Gaps in College Readiness Between Racial/Ethnic Groups

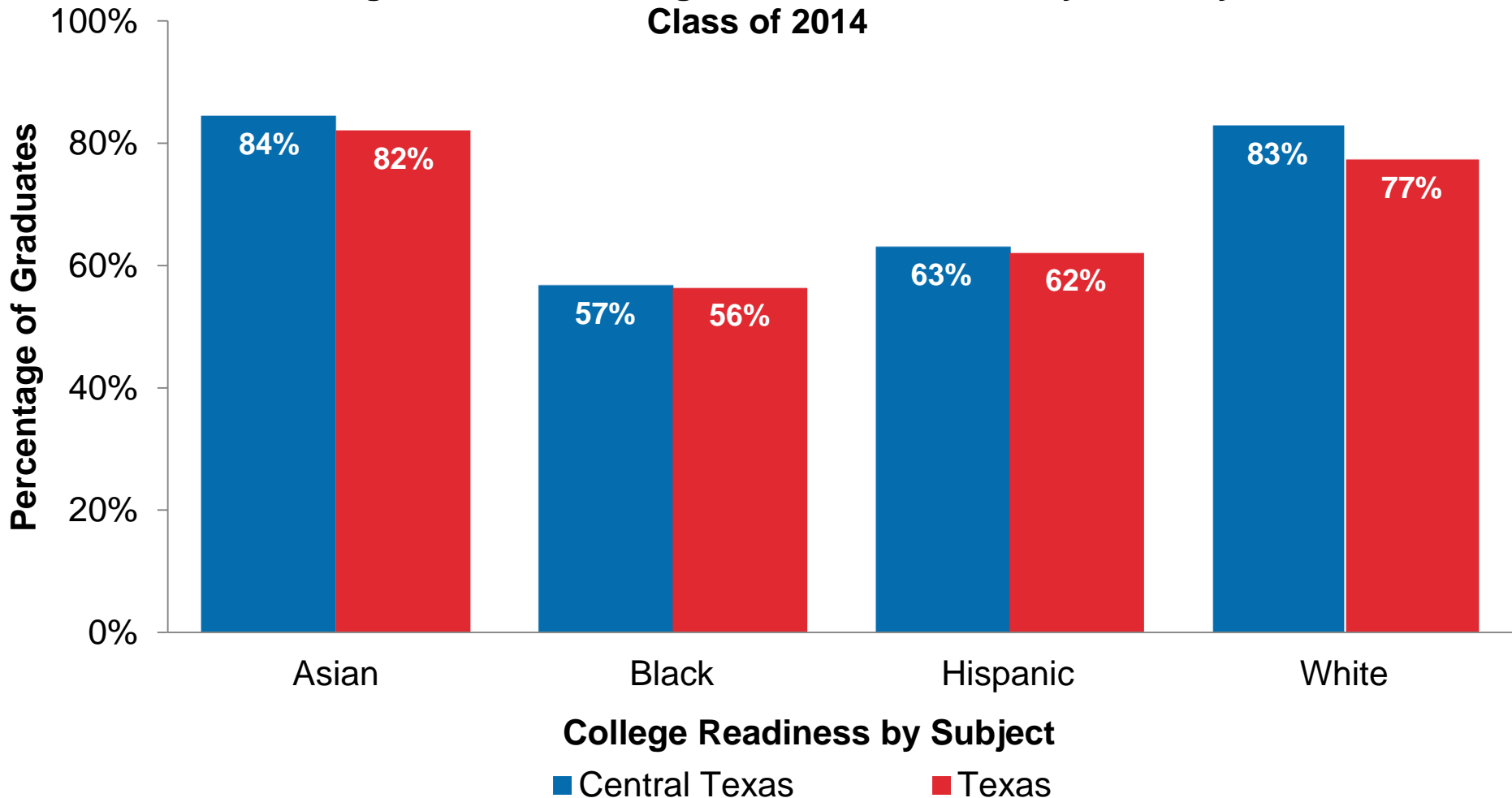
Central Texas Rates of College Readiness in Math Higher Than Texas for White and Asian Graduates

Class of 2014



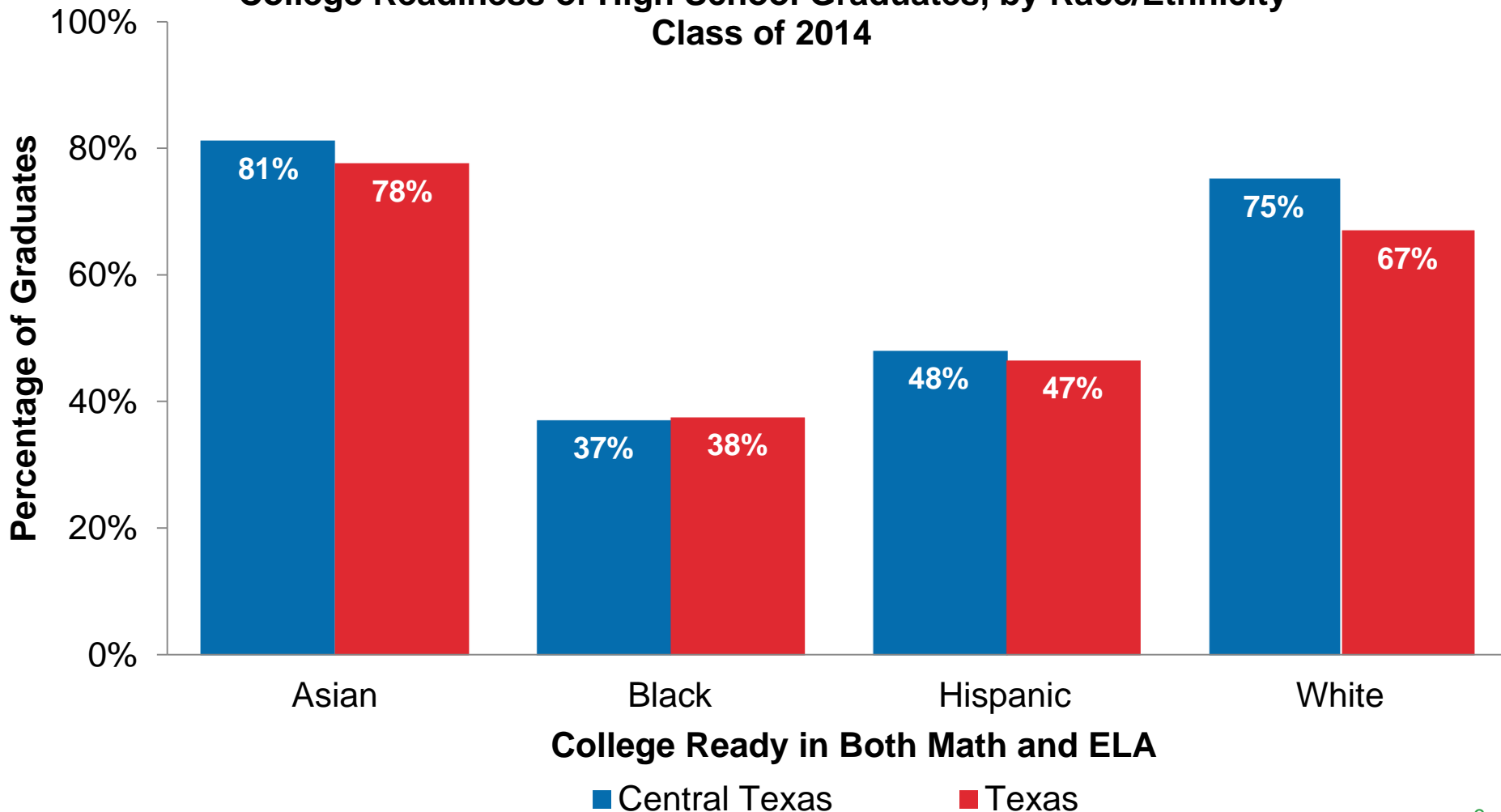
Central Texas College Readiness Rates in Reading Similar or Higher Than Texas But Gaps are Larger
