




School and Work Status, First Year After High School Gentral Texas, 9th Grade Cohort, 2006-2007






Income Composition, First Year After High School Central Texas, 9th Grade Cohort, 2006-2007

Racial/Ethnic Composition, First Year After High School Central Texas, 9th Grade Cohort, 2006-2007



Employment Status and Earnings, First Year After High School Central Texas, 9th Grade Cohort, 2006-2007






Pathways Reflection Activity




School and Work Status, 6th Year After High School Gentral Texas, 9th Grade Cohort, 2006-2007
