Who is E3 Alliance?

E3 Alliance is a regional, data-driven education collaborative based in Austin, Texas. We are helping to build the strongest educational pipeline in the country to drive regional economic prosperity by breaking down barriers and building better alignment across the education continuum. Our name tells our story: Education Equals Economics. We believe that only through greater educational achievement can Central Texas realize sustained economic prosperity and a higher quality of life.

In 2020-21 alone, E3-led initiatives directly benefitted 351,113 Central Texas students.

- Created the **first** multi-competency, student-centered standard for Kindergarten Readiness in Texas
- Conducted ground-breaking research leading to **12** regional school districts substantially changing policies to support student success in math
- Launched and facilitated the Austin College Attainment Network (ACAN) to support first-generation college goers, growing from 1,500 to **16,000+** students
- Supported Emergency Bridge Funding for college students from low-income households in Central Texas, resulting in **90%+** of these recipients persisting in college
